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
Incremental Innovation Strategy

Contextual Diversity

- Care system characteristics (e.g. governance, funding)
- Efforts for service improvement prior to VIGOUR (e.g. organisationally, technologically)
- Strategic focus on integration efforts (e.g. main "pain points")

Processual Diversity


- Contextualised care integration focus & approach

Developing the project

- Read the call / program text carefully
- Assess realistically to what extent the call / programme objectives match with strategic objectives of your region.
- Develop a convincing project plan that matches the call objectives
- Develop KPIs that are ambitious and at the same time achievable
- Estimate the project budget realistically
- Bring together a convincing proposal

Implementing the project

- Put in place an effective project management structure
- Monitor progress, both content wise and contract wise
- Monitor project risks and be prepared to react to emerging challenges
- Don't underestimate management vis-a-vis the Commission



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
