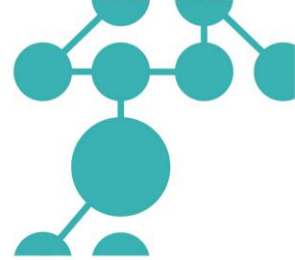


SUMMARY OF THE EU4HEALTH 2023 WORK PROGRAMME

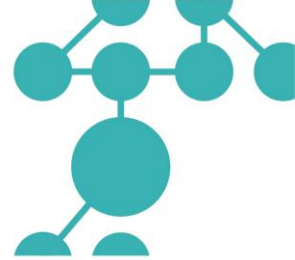
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| <p>GENERAL OBJECTIVES</p> | <p>EU4Health is the 4th funding programme for health in force for the period 2021-2027. The program aims to integrate Member States' policies to improve human health by ensuring its protection in all Union policies and activities in line with the One Health approach.</p> <p>The 2023 Work programme pursues the following general objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • improve and foster health in the EU in order to reduce the burden of communicable and non-communicable diseases by supporting health promotion and disease prevention, reducing health inequalities, promoting healthy lifestyles and promoting access to health care; • protect people from serious cross-border threats to health and strengthen the preparedness and response capacity of health systems and coordination between Member States to address serious cross-border threats to health; • improve the availability, accessibility and affordability of medicinal products, medical devices and crisis-relevant products in the EU and support innovation in relation to these products; • strengthen health systems by improving their resilience and develop resource efficiency, in particular by: supporting integrated and coordinated work between Member States; promoting the implementation of best practices and data sharing; strengthening the health workforce; addressing the implications of demographic challenges; driving the digital transformation forward. |
| <p>BUDGET</p> | <p>The overall budgetary envelope of the European Commission for 2023 amounts to EUR 735 788 071 of which EUR 428 260 000 will be grants, EUR 176 428 071 will be procurement (both under direct management) and EUR 131 100 000 will be under indirect management, divided into 6 different strands and areas of action as follows:</p> <p>1.
