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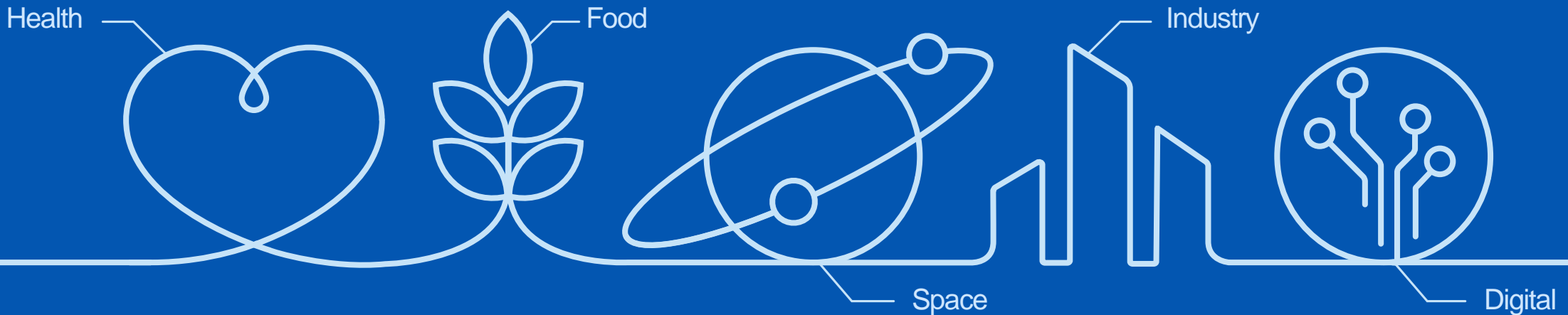

Liaises with National Focal Points (NFPs)

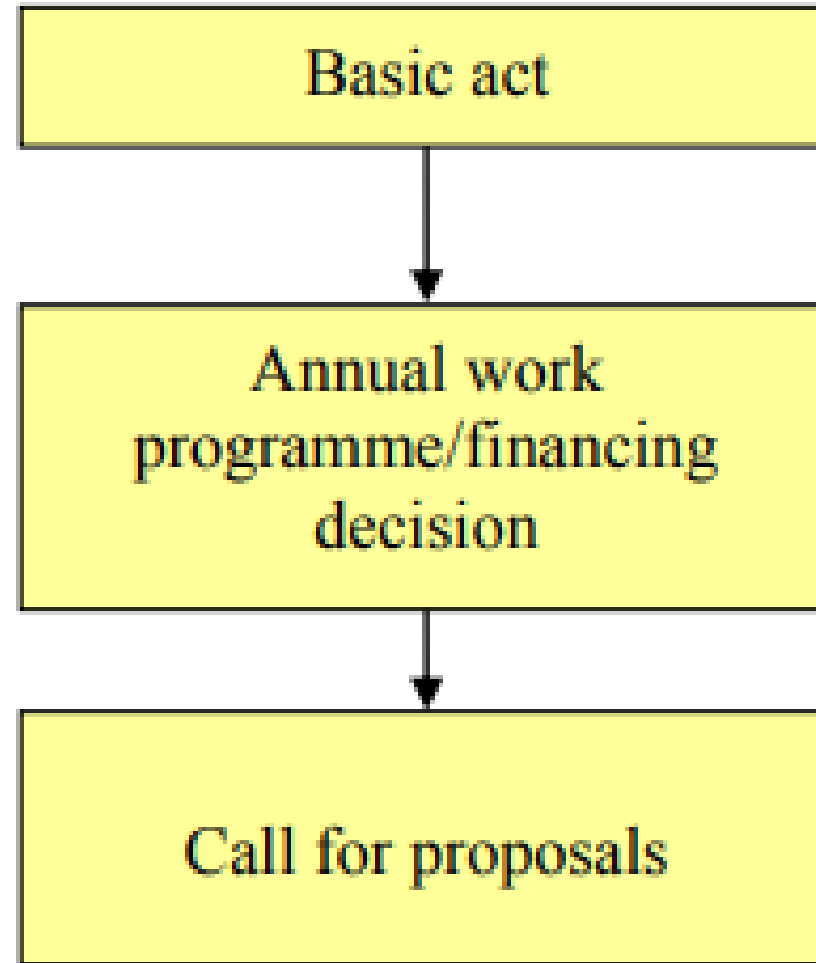
Representatives appointed by national health ministries



Manages the third health programme

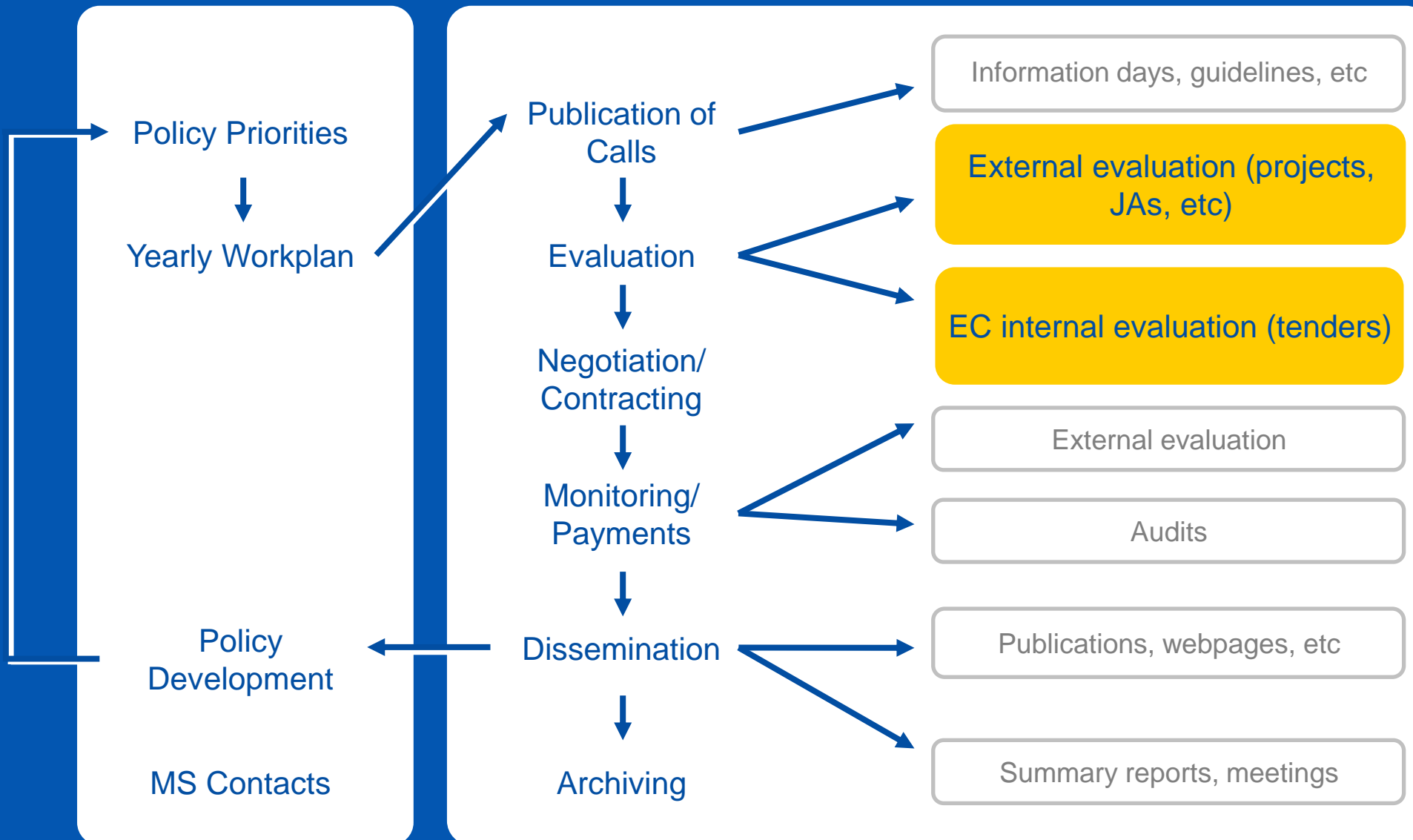

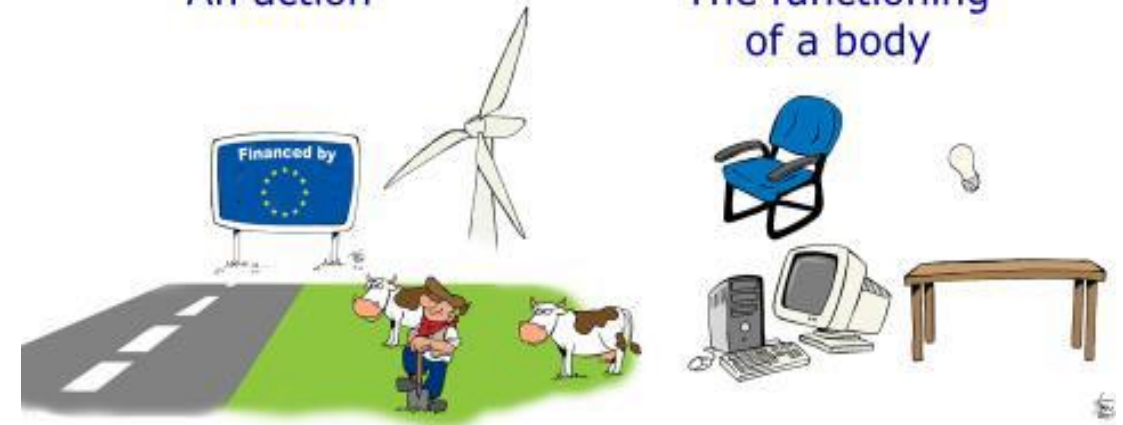
Grants

Grants are financial contributions from the European Union budget awarded by way of a donation to a third-party (= the beneficiary) engaged in activities that serve Union policies

A grant is a donation to finance

An action

The functioning
of a body



Grants fall into two broad categories:

1. Grants for actions

intended to help achieving objectives that are part of a Union policy

2. Operating grants

that finance the functioning of a body whose objectives are part of a Union policy. These are based on a work programme



The successful applicant for a grant becomes the "**beneficiary**".

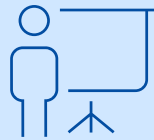

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Final tips - before submitting

The project addresses the essential requirements of the call for proposals.

There is a good fit between the project objectives and the expertise.

The resources requested are adequately justified in the proposal.

There is a clear plan for implementation and project management.

The proposal details contingency plans in case things go wrong.


The proposal describes a communication and dissemination plan.
