(1) EU Health Policy Platform - Overview

1. The working language is English.

- **Other EU languages** only in new networks created on ad-hoc basis.

2. Represent an organisation with an operative and individual email.

3. Be a European, national, regional or local entity, registered in an EU Member State, EEA-country or a country participating in the funding of the EU4Health programme.

- Organisations from third countries may also register on the EU Health Policy Platform and will be considered on an ad hoc basis and at the discretion of the Commission.

4. Be registered in the EU Transparency Register.

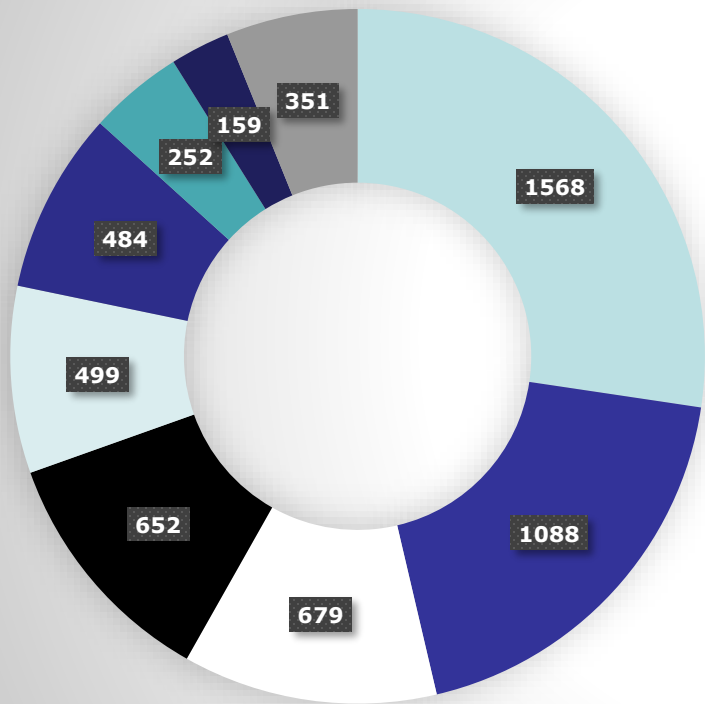
(1) EU Health Policy Platform - Overview

[The Platform in short]

- 5786 **Platform members**
- 66 **networks**
- **25 Joint Statements** produced in 7 Thematic Network cycles
- Around 60 **live webinars** organised annually
- **Platform newsletter** sent to all Platform members twice a week gathering the latest posts on EU Health Policy
- **Trainings** organised for Platform users and moderators twice per year (16 and 21 March. Next round: Autumn 2023)

Networks gathering health stakeholders on a specific health policy area and created upon request by registered users.

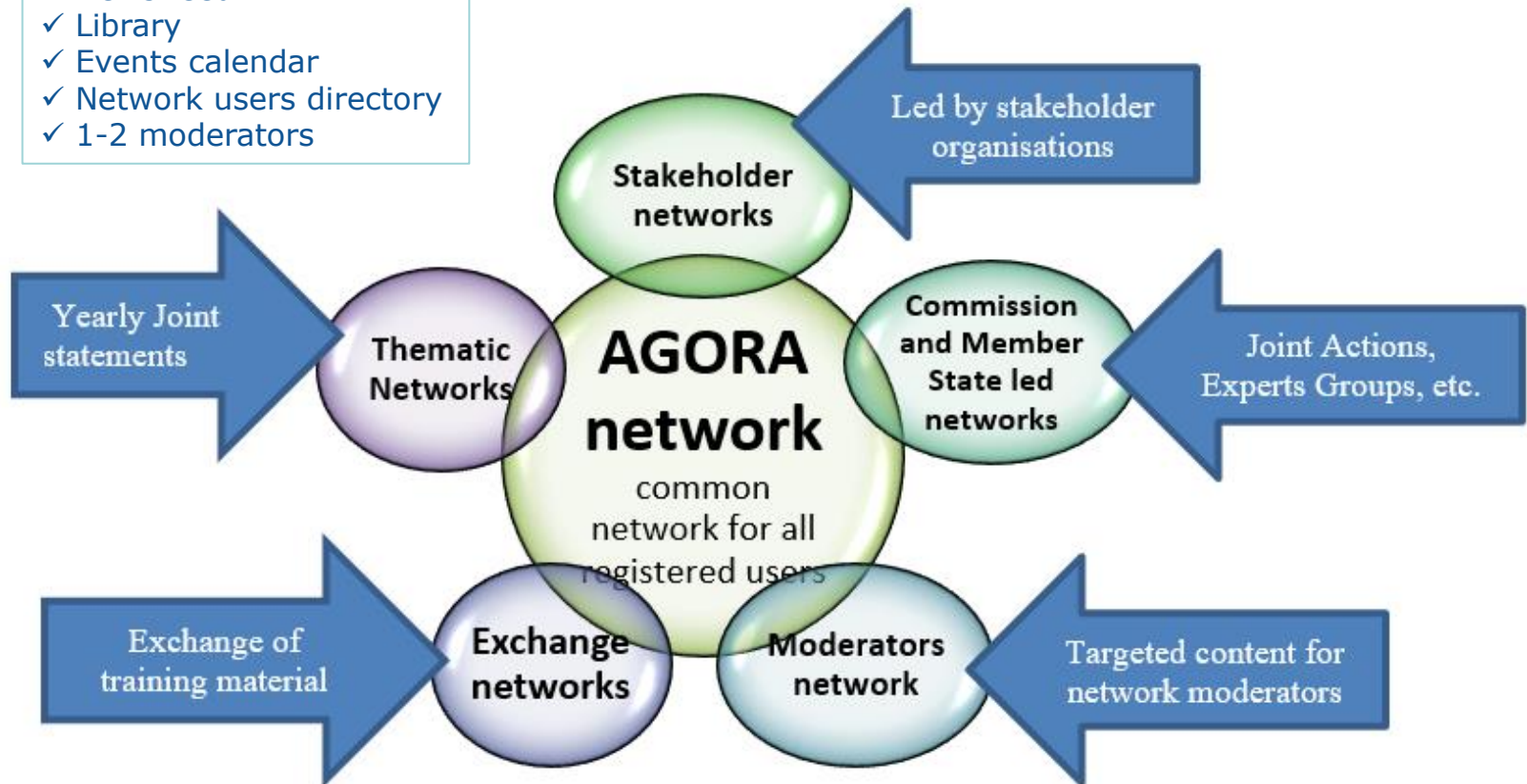

(3) EU Health Policy Platform - Networks

Six types of NETWORKS

- 1. Agora Network: first filter to the Platform.** It is a **common space** where all registered users can post news and events and discuss issues of common interest.
- 2. Thematic Networks:** temporary networks for stakeholders to speak with one voice, where a leading organisation prepares **Joint Statements** on agreed health issues. All users with access to the Agora can enter these networks. The Thematic Networks cycle last between 6 to 9 months.
- 3. Exchange networks:** open to all registered users, some meant to host training material for health professionals.
- 4. Stakeholder networks:** for and by stakeholders, used to prepare and follow-up meetings; share, work on and store documents. Access to these networks is restricted.
- 5. Commission and Member State-led networks:** administered by EC or MS, prepare and follow-up meetings; share, work on and store documents. Access to these networks is restricted.
- 6. Moderators' Network:** this network is used to familiarise Platform network moderators with the EU Health Policy Platform and to provide trainings for them.



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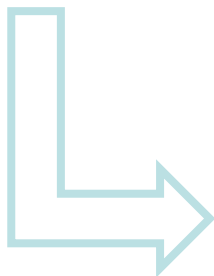
