Synergies 2021-2027

In the 2021-2027 programming, the European Commission intended and intends **to promote the use of synergies** between the **ordinary programs** included in the Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF), the **Structural Funds**, and the programs belonging to the **Next Generation EU** package, trying to simplify and untie those knots that in the previous programming have compromised a wider and real implementation





The aim of synergies between EU Structural and Investment Funds and Horizon Europe is to maximize the scientific, economic and social impact of the resources foreseen in the 2021-2027 Multi-annual Financial Framework, as well as to increase investments in research and innovation by leveraging different sources of financing.


- At political level: a shared vision


OBJECTIVES OF new provisions and the guidance

1.**SIMPLIFICATION** \rightarrow easy implementation, less red tape and administration

2.**NEW OPPORTUNITIES** \rightarrow diversification but fully respecting the specific objectives of each programme

3.LEGAL CERTAINTY -> clarity of rules and concrete steps

Synergies: Wide RANGE OF OPPORTUNITIES





Key types of Synergies & Expected impacts

Alternative

- Use of HE eligible costs/funding rate
- Exemption from state
 aid notification
- No new technical evaluation
- Seal of Excellence
 EIC business
 acceleration services

Combined

- Use of cohesion funds as MS contribution in Partnerships
- Favorable state aid rules for cofunded projects in partnerships

Transfers

- Shift from shared management funds to HE
- Transfer-back of unused funds to originating programs

Cumulative

Use of several Union programs to fund the same action



Seal of Excellence Pipeline of excellent R&I projects identified for funding

Leverage of Horizon Europe mechanisms and visibility + economic impact at regional level



Support to Partnerships ERDF as MS contribution in Horizon Europe partnerships

major incentive for participation of regional actors + alignment towards common EU priorities



relieves regional ERDF Managing Authorities from setting up a full administrative system for evaluating and following projects + learning effect for firms entering Horizon Europe

Support to Partnerships ERDF as MS contribution in Horizon Europe partnerships

major incentive for participation of regional actors + alignment towards common EU priorities Financial contributions from programmes co financed by European Structural and Investment Funds may be considered as contribution of a Member State for participating in Horizon Europe

Example 1: Co funded Partnerships under Horizon Europe (where national funding bodies provide financial support to third parties, which are reimbursed by Commission)

Example 2: Institutionalised European Partnership (Article 185/7) partnerships, under certain conditions
