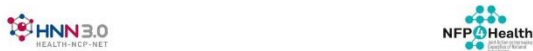

Under the current Multi-annual Financial Framework of the European Union (MF 2021 - 2027), actions that pertain to improving health and well-being in the EU and beyond are supported by multiple streams of funding, covering different dimensions of action, and working in synergy with each other. ## Synergien zwischen EU4Health und anderen europäischen Programmen

Das Gesundheitsprogramm EU4Health wird durch den **mehrwährigen Finanzrahmen der europäischen Kommission (multiannual financial framework, MFF) 2021-2027**, ergänzt durch **NextGenerationEU (NGEU)**, finanziert. Das Budget der europäischen Kommission widmet sich Prioritäten wie der Forschung und Innovation, dem Klima, dem digitalen Wandel, und der Widerstandsfähigkeit von Gesundheitssystemen.

Um die verschiedenen strategischen Bereiche zu adressieren **finanziert der MFF verschiedene Fonds und Programme**, die in **sieben Kategorien** zusammengefasst sind. Die Kategorien sind zwar jeweils einem bestimmten Politikbereich gewidmet, es bestehen jedoch signifikante inhaltliche Synergien und Komplementaritäten, sodass für viele bereichsübergreifende Prioritäten thematische Anknüpfungspunkte in mehreren verschiedenen Fonds und Programmen bestehen.

## Beating cancer together: Synergistic EU-initiatives

### EUROPE'S BEATING CANCER PLAN

A strategy with 4 key action areas, tackling the entire disease pathway:

- Prevention
- Early detection
- Diagnosis and treatment
- Quality of life of cancer patients and survivors



Funding for the implementation of the EBCP flows mainly through the EU4Health Programme and Horizon Europe, as well as the Digital Europe Programme and others to a lesser extent.

- Quality of life for patients and their families

EU Missions are a novelty in the current EU programming period and aim to deliver concrete results on pivotal challenges that Europe faces.
