Participating organizations by countries

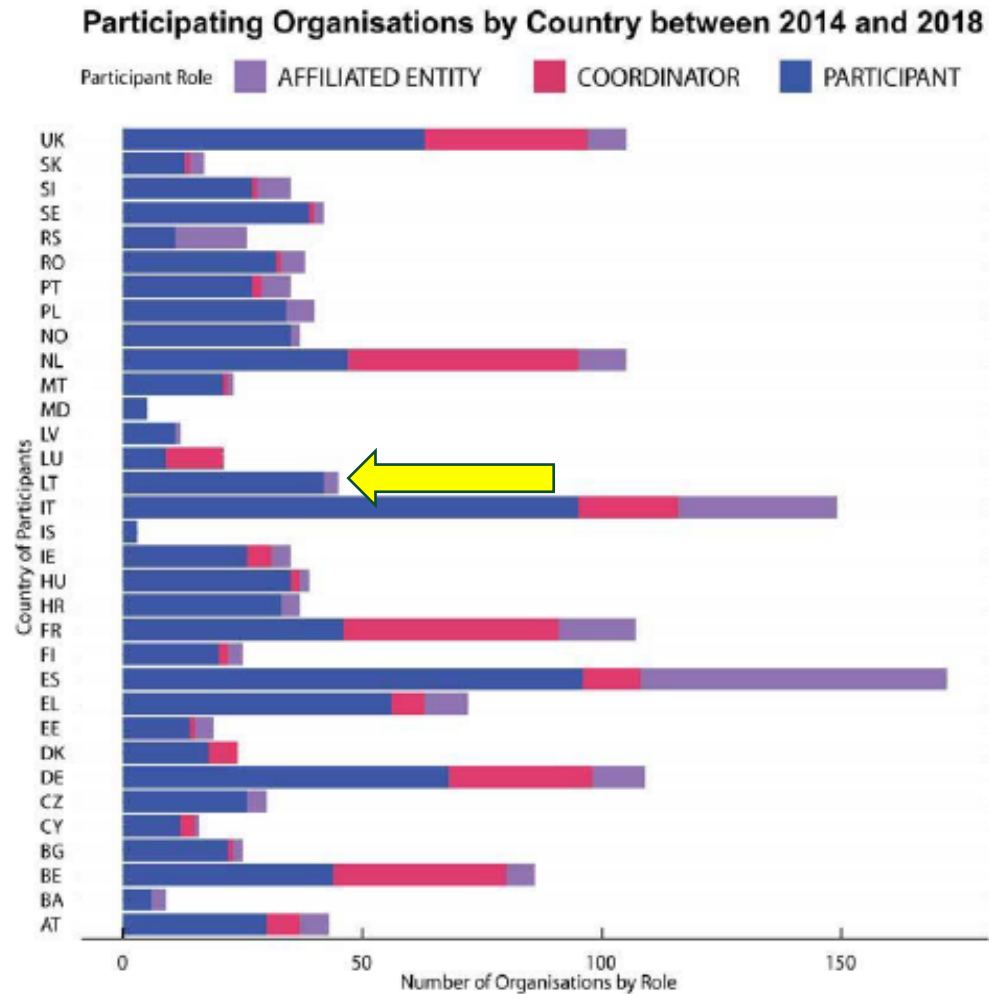
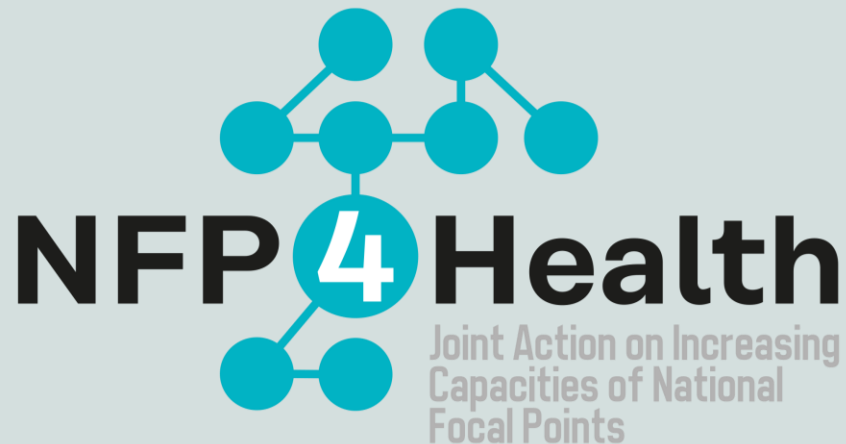


FIGURE 2 FUNDS ALLOCATED BY COUNTRY AND BY ROLE 2014-2018 (PROPORTIONAL TO THE DARKNESS OF THE COLOR)

- **ONCODIR: Evidence-based Participatory Decision Making for Cancer Prevention through implementation** will identify risk factors associated with colorectal cancer and will integrate multidisciplinary research methods and technologies (including health policy analytics, artificial intelligence and decision support theories) to deliver evidence-based and personalised recommendations on colorectal cancer prevention.

Synergies/Results: EU Civil Protection Mechanism's rescEU medical stocks funded by the Health Emergency Preparedness and Response Authority (HERA)

- From 2024, Lithuania will provide a facility to accommodate the European Union medical stockpile provisions required to manage cross-border threats and to ensure an effective response to crises at the Community level.
- As part of the rescEU project, Lithuania will set up a warehouse to store medical supplies to meet the requirements of the EU Civil Protection Mechanism.
- The European Commission will allocate 97 million euros for the provision of this facility.

EU funds further strategic reserves for medical, chemical, biological and radio-nuclear emergencies worth €690 million

The Commission is allocating today around €690 million to Czechia, Finland, France, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal and Romania to further develop the rescEU strategic reserves of medical and chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear (CBRN) items.

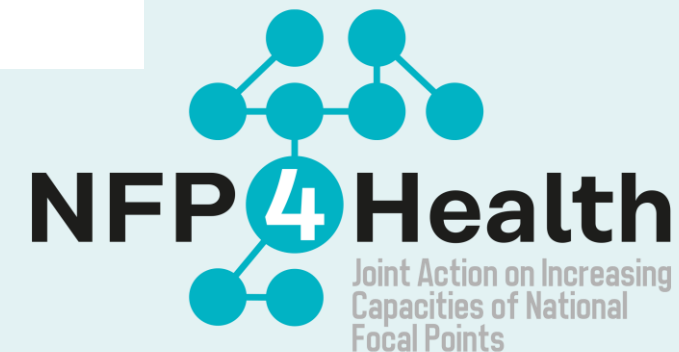
